DERSİN TANIMI

Kriminoloji dersi, suçun multidisipliner bir perspektiften incelendiği, öğrencilere suçun karmaşıklığını anlama, analitik düşünce becerilerini geliştirme ve kriminolojik teorilerin uygulanabilirliğini anlama fırsatı sunan bir derstir. Bu derste, öğrenciler, suçun biyolojik, psikolojik, sosyolojik ve kültürel boyutlarına dair kapsamlı bir anlayış geliştirirler. Suçun evrimi ve toplumsal etkileri incelenerek, suçun bireyler, topluluklar ve toplum üzerindeki kompleks etkileşimleri detaylı bir şekilde ele alınır. Temel kriminoloji kavramları ve kriminolojik araştırma yöntemleri, öğrencilere bilimsel bir bakış açısı kazandırarak suçun temel dinamiklerini anlamalarını sağlar.

Bu ders, suçun nedenleri, suç tipleri, suçlu profilleri ve suçla mücadele stratejileri üzerine odaklanarak, öğrencilere kriminoloji disiplindeki güncel konularla ilgili bilgi ve beceri kazandırmayı hedefler. Aynı zamanda, öğrencilere suçun sosyal, kültürel ve teknolojik bağlamlarını anlama ve suçla mücadelede etkili stratejileri değerlendirme becerisi kazandırmayı amaçlar. Bu kapsamlı ders, öğrencilere suçun doğasını anlamak ve toplumsal adalet sistemine katkıda bulunmak için gerekli olan bilgi ve analitik yetenekleri kazandırarak kriminoloji alanındaki bilinç düzeyini artırmayı amaçlar.

DERSİN AMACI

Kriminoloji dersinin temel hedefi, öğrencilere kriminoloji disiplinde güçlü bir temel oluşturarak, suç olgusunu derinlemesine ve objektif bir perspektiften anlamalarını sağlamaktır. Bu bağlamda, ders, öğrencilere kriminolojik araştırmaların temel metodolojik yaklaşımlarını öğretmekle kalmaz, aynı zamanda bu yöntemleri eleştirel bir düşünce çerçevesi içinde değerlendirme becerilerini geliştirmelerine fırsat tanır.

Dersin bir diğer önemli amacı, öğrencilere suçun nedenlerini ve suçlu profillerini anlamaları için güçlü bir analitik çerçeve sunarak, suçla mücadele stratejileri konusunda kritik düşünce becerilerini geliştirmektir. Bu, öğrencilerin suçun sosyal, kültürel ve teknolojik bağlamlarını kapsamlı bir şekilde anlamalarına ve suçun toplumsal etkilerini daha derinlemesine değerlendirmelerine olanak tanır.

Kriminoloji dersinin içeriği güncel kriminoloji literatüründen beslenerek, öğrencilere kriminoloji disiplindeki en son gelişmeleri takip etme ve bu alandaki güncel araştırma ve inceleme becerilerini geliştirme şansı sunar. Bu sayede, öğrencilerin suç ve adalet sistemi arasındaki karmaşık ilişkileri objektif bir perspektiften değerlendirebilme yetisi kazanmaları ve kriminoloji disiplinde öne çıkan düşünürler ve araştırmacılar arasında yer alabilmeleri amaçlanır.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Criminology course is an opportunity for students to examine crime from a multidisciplinary perspective, enabling them to understand the complexity of crime, develop analytical thinking skills, and comprehend the applicability of criminological theories. In this course, students cultivate a comprehensive understanding of the biological, psychological, sociological, and cultural dimensions of crime. By exploring the evolution of crime and its societal impacts, the intricate interactions of crime on individuals, communities, and society are extensively addressed. Fundamental criminology concepts and research methods provide students with a scientific perspective, allowing them to grasp the fundamental dynamics of crime. This course aims to equip students with knowledge and skills related to current issues in the discipline of criminology, focusing on the causes of crime, types of crime, profiles of offenders, and strategies to combat crime. Simultaneously, it aims to enhance students' understanding of the social, cultural, and technological contexts of crime and develop their ability to evaluate effective strategies in crime prevention. The comprehensive nature of this course seeks to elevate students' awareness in the field of criminology by providing them with the necessary knowledge and analytical skills to comprehend the nature of crime and contribute to the societal justice system.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The fundamental objective of the Criminology course is to provide students with a robust foundation in the discipline of criminology, enabling them to comprehend the phenomenon of crime in-depth and from an objective perspective. In this context, the course not only teaches students the fundamental methodological approaches of criminological research but also provides them with the opportunity to develop critical evaluation skills within a framework of critical thinking.

Another crucial aim of the course is to enhance students' critical thinking skills regarding crime prevention strategies by offering a strong analytical framework for understanding the causes of crime and offender profiles. This allows students to comprehensively understand the social, cultural, and technological contexts of crime and delve deeper into evaluating the societal impacts of crime.

The content of the Criminology course draws from the latest criminology literature, providing students with the chance to stay updated on the latest developments in the discipline and to develop skills in current research and analysis in this field. Consequently, the goal is for students to acquire the ability to objectively assess the complex relationships between crime and the justice system and to potentially emerge as prominent thinkers and researchers in the field of criminology.
